

# VISITOR GUIDELINES

We are excited to welcome you to Oglethorpe University so you can experience the beauty of our historic campus for yourself. To ensure the health and safety of the OU community and our visitors, we have established the following policies based on public health guidance from the CDC, state and local authorities.

## Before Your Visit

All visitors are required to register in advance of arriving on campus. To register for a campus tour, visit [oglethorpe.edu/visit](https://oglethorpe.edu/visit). To ensure that as many students as possible are able to visit campus and maintain low density tour groups, we are limiting all families to three (3) members: the prospective student, and two (2) guests. We are not able to accommodate any walk-in visitors on to campus.

## Check For COVID-19 Symptoms

If you or another member of your family is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 or has recently been in contact with someone who contracted COVID-19, please reschedule your visit. Visitors will be asked COVID-19 screening questions upon arrival.

## Face Coverings & Hygiene

All visitors are required to wear a face covering while visiting our campus. Face coverings should cover both your nose and mouth. Face coverings must be worn at all times while on campus property, both inside and outside of university buildings. Any guests who do not have their own face covering will be provided a disposable mask to wear during their visit.

Bottled water will be available when you check-in. While we are eager to meet you in person, our admission staff and student tour guides will not be shaking hands out of an abundance of caution.

## On the Day of Your Visit

On the day of your scheduled campus visit, you will first check-in with our security team at the gatehouse as you enter campus. Please tell them your name and that you are scheduled for a tour with Admissions. They will direct you to visitor parking outside Lupton Hall. Additional arrival and check-in information will be included in your confirmation and reminder emails.

Tour groups will be limited to ten (10) guests, including students, per tour guide. For the safety of our campus community, residence halls will not be shown on the tour and we are limiting the number of building interiors that tour groups will visit.

You will have the opportunity to speak briefly with an Admission Counselor either before or after your tour, but we are unable to provide in-person admission presentations. We encourage you to schedule a virtual meeting with your assigned admission counselor for a full admission presentation, and to get answers to any remaining questions you may have.
